For more than 50 years Epilepsy Foundation has been delivering help and hope to people impacted by epilepsy. This year over 2,800 calls have been made to our epilepsy helpline and we have trained over 2,000 staff around VIC & NSW.

In the last 12 months we have supported 884 new individuals and their families at the Foundation who rely on us for information and support.

We believe that no one with epilepsy should go it alone.

What is epilepsy?

Epilepsy is the most common serious neurological condition in the world. Each week 280 Australians will be diagnosed and sadly 5 will die from epilepsy-related causes. Up to 50% of people with epilepsy do not know the cause and 30% of people will not gain seizure control with medication.
